

DOMESTIC ABUSE IS...

one person in a relationship or in the family using violence or abuse to cause fear and get control over the other person. It may take the form of beating, insult threats, blackmailing, financial control or rape. Domestic abuse will not go away on its own. It tends to get worse and become more frequent over time, harming you and your children.

If you...

- want to speak to somebody
 - need assistance in clarifying further steps
 - need somebody to encourage you
 - look for further information, advice and assistance
 - want to go to a women's refuge

IF YOU ARE PLANNING TO LEAVE A DOMESTIC ABUSE SITUATION MAKE AN ESCAPE PLAN!

FIND A safe place to store your important documents and items. E.g. at a friend's house or at work. Important documents: Public Service Card, medical cards, passports, birth certificate, marriage certificate.

IF possible make photocopies of these. Keep some money in a safe place for taxis, bus fare and phone calls.

KEEP a bag with clothes, prescription medications and toiletries for you and the children in a safe place outside the home (including spare school uniforms).

WHEN you are leaving it is important that all children leave with you, if this is a safe option.

REMEMBER to bring your mobile phone, money, bank cards and any medication such as inhalers and any current prescription.
