OUR VISION

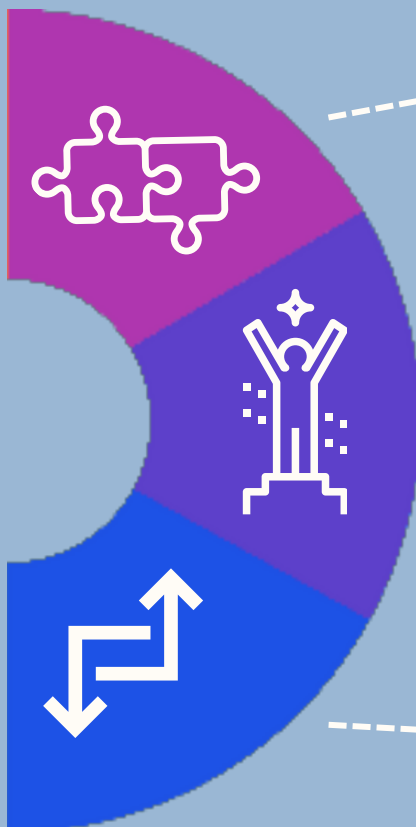


women supporting women

Integration

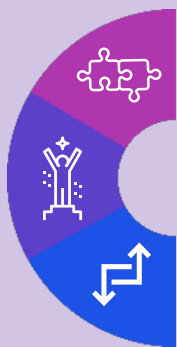
Supporting women to participate in society, new communities and grow through two-way intercultural awareness.

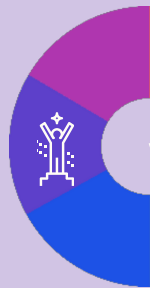

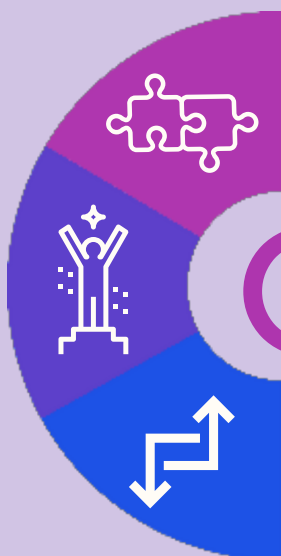

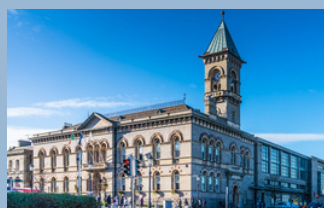
